Notes:

- (a) Program/Activity/Project Title — refers to the 'official' title of the program/activity/project under the Comprehensive Livelihood and Emergency Employment Program (CLEEP), based on the 10 February 2009 Memorandum of the President to all Cabinet members transmitted by Executive Secretary Eduardo R. Ermita in a memorandum dated 13 February 2009.
- (b) Performance Indicator — refers to the output achieved by the program to indicate attainment/accomplishment of its activities. Output or outcome indicators are dependent on the nature of the program/activity/project being implemented. The agency-respondent may put in additional indicators other than: (1) number of jobs generated, (2) number of individuals employed, and/or (3) no. of population served.
- (c) (Physical) Target — refers to what the program/activity/project wants to achieve.
- (d) (Physical) Accomplishment — refers to actual output/outcome of the program/activity/project during the reporting period.
- (e) (Physical) % Accomplishment — refers to percentage of accomplishments versus the target set.

- (f) (Financial) Source — refers to whether the funds used for the program/activity/project come from agency GAA, foreign or private funding, or local government counterpart.
- (g) (Financial) Allocation — refers to the total fund investment for the program/activity/project.
- (h) (Financial) Obligation — refers to actual cost expended for the program/activity/project.
- (i) (Financial) % Utilization — refers to percentage of obligation versus allocation.
- (j) Timeframe — refers to the start and end/completion date of the program/activity/project.
- (k) Remarks — refers to comments, explanations of the inputs to the monitoring report.
